Paul introduces the Jews and non-Jewish believers in the God of Israel to the new thing that God has done for them in Jesus, whom he has raised up for them as Saviour.

GOSPEL ACCLAMATION

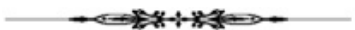
Alleluia, alleluia!

GOSPEL ACCLAMATION

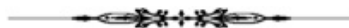
Alleluia, alleluia!
